Community energy at Trent Basin —

The Community Energy Project at Trent Basin is a groundbreaking energy scheme that aims to change the way we generate and use energy in local communities throughout the UK.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Renewable energy, generated by solar panels located throughout the Trent Basin neighbourhood, is stored in Europe's largest community energy battery (supplied by Tesla) and then used by the National Grid.

Trent Basin Energy Services Company (ESCO) Ltd - the company set up to run

the project – will generate income by selling energy to the National Grid. The ESCO will be co-owned by Trent Basin residents, who will be invited to get involved with project decision-making and will be entitled to an agreed share of any surplus income.
